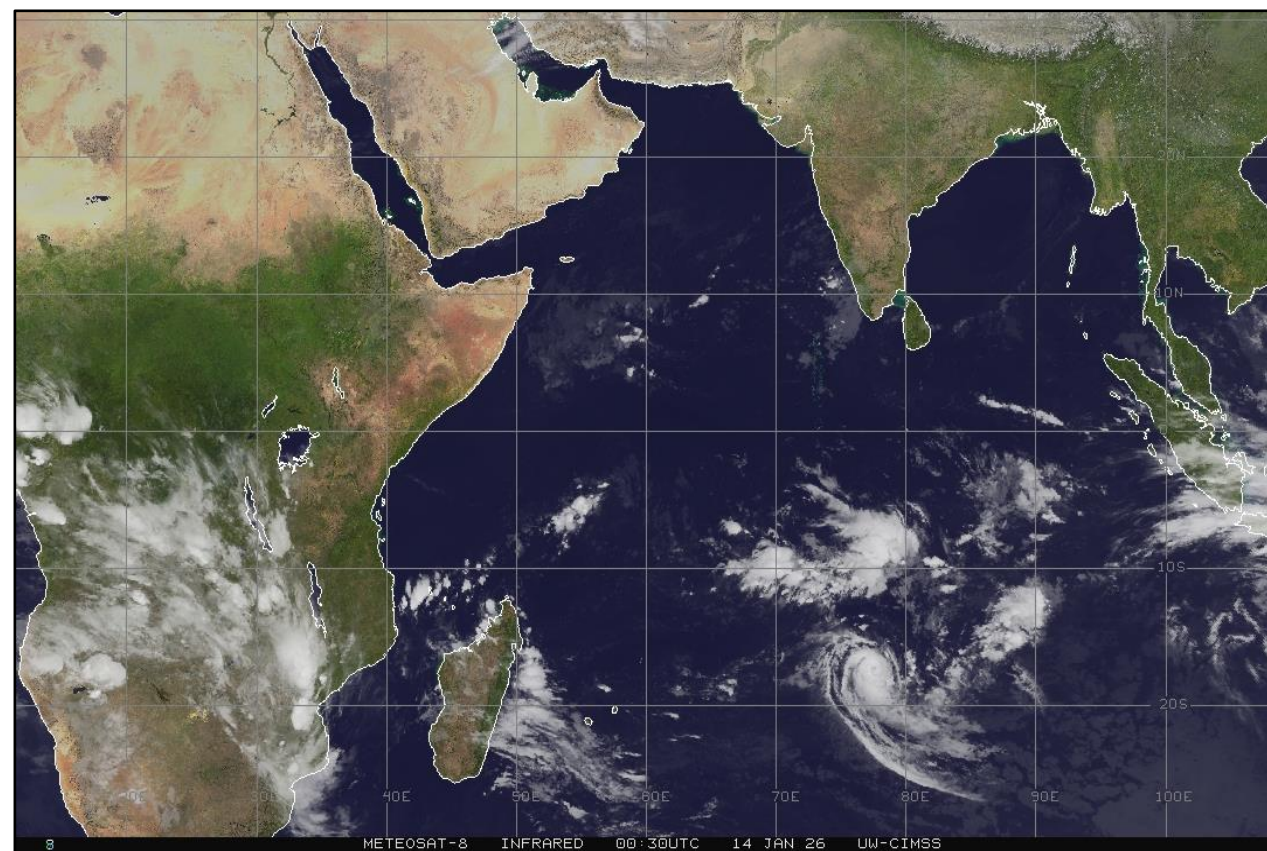

OCNL Showers / T'Showers in sections : 55, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85

SCT Showers / T'Showers in sections : 00, 05, 25, 45, 60

ISOL Showers / T'Showers elsewhere.

Winds:

North of Shear line : NE'ly to E'ly/ (10-20)kts; gusting up to 25 kts in section 05.

In-between Shear line and ITCZ :NW'ly or W'ly / (05-15) kts; gusting up to 25 kts in sections 60 and 65

South of ITCZ:

Cyclonic /(10-20)kts; gusting up to 25 kts in section 80

Seas:

Fairly Rough, rough at times in sections : 05, 80

Moderate, fairly rough at times in sections : 00, 10, 25, 55, 60, 65, 70

Slight to Moderate elsewhere.

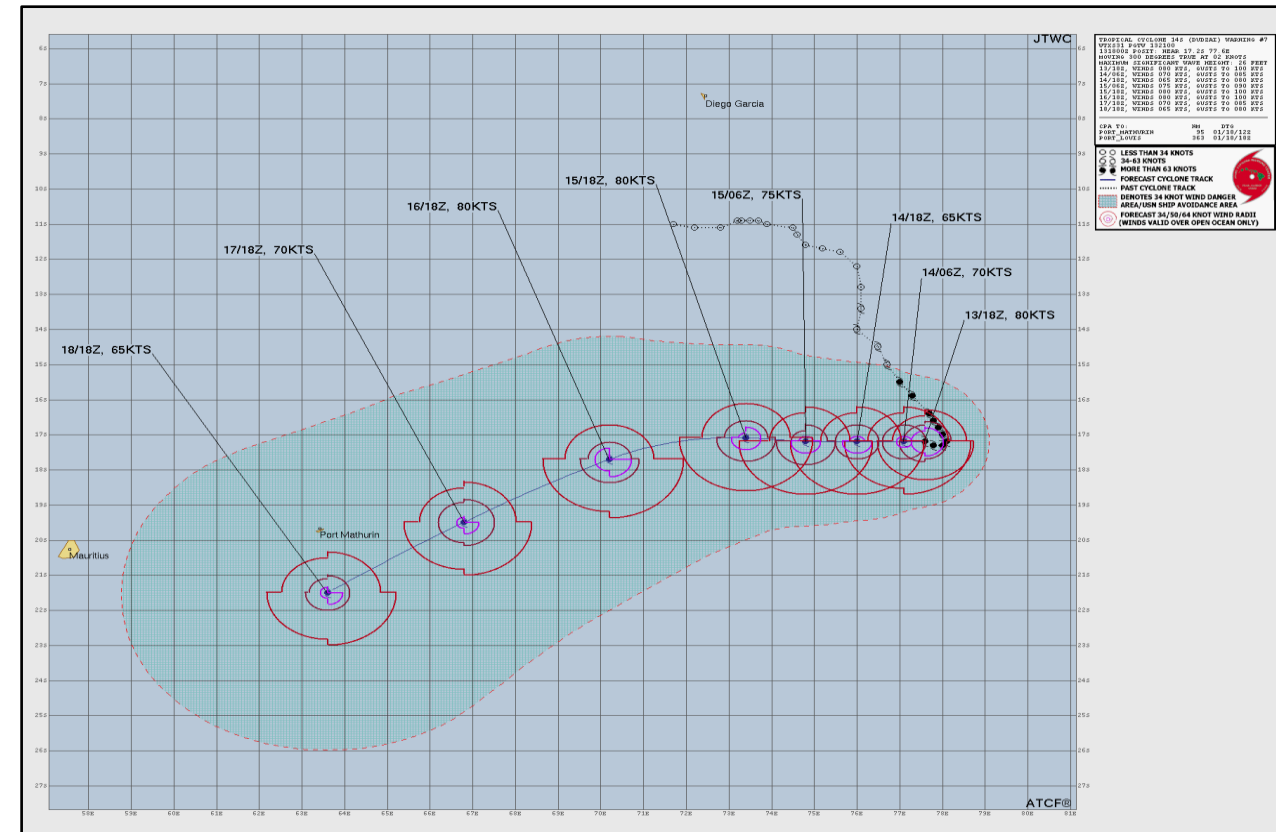
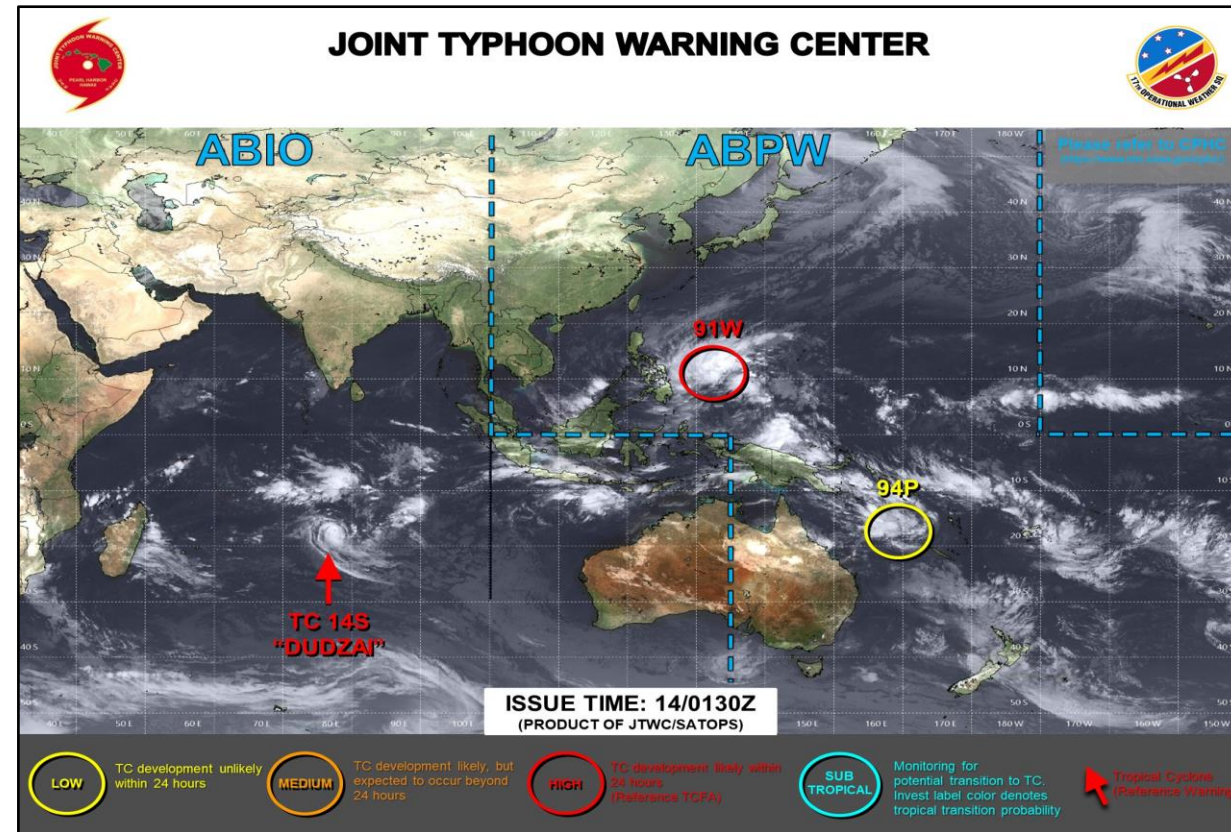
NOTE: Seas can be temporarily very rough during thundershowers.

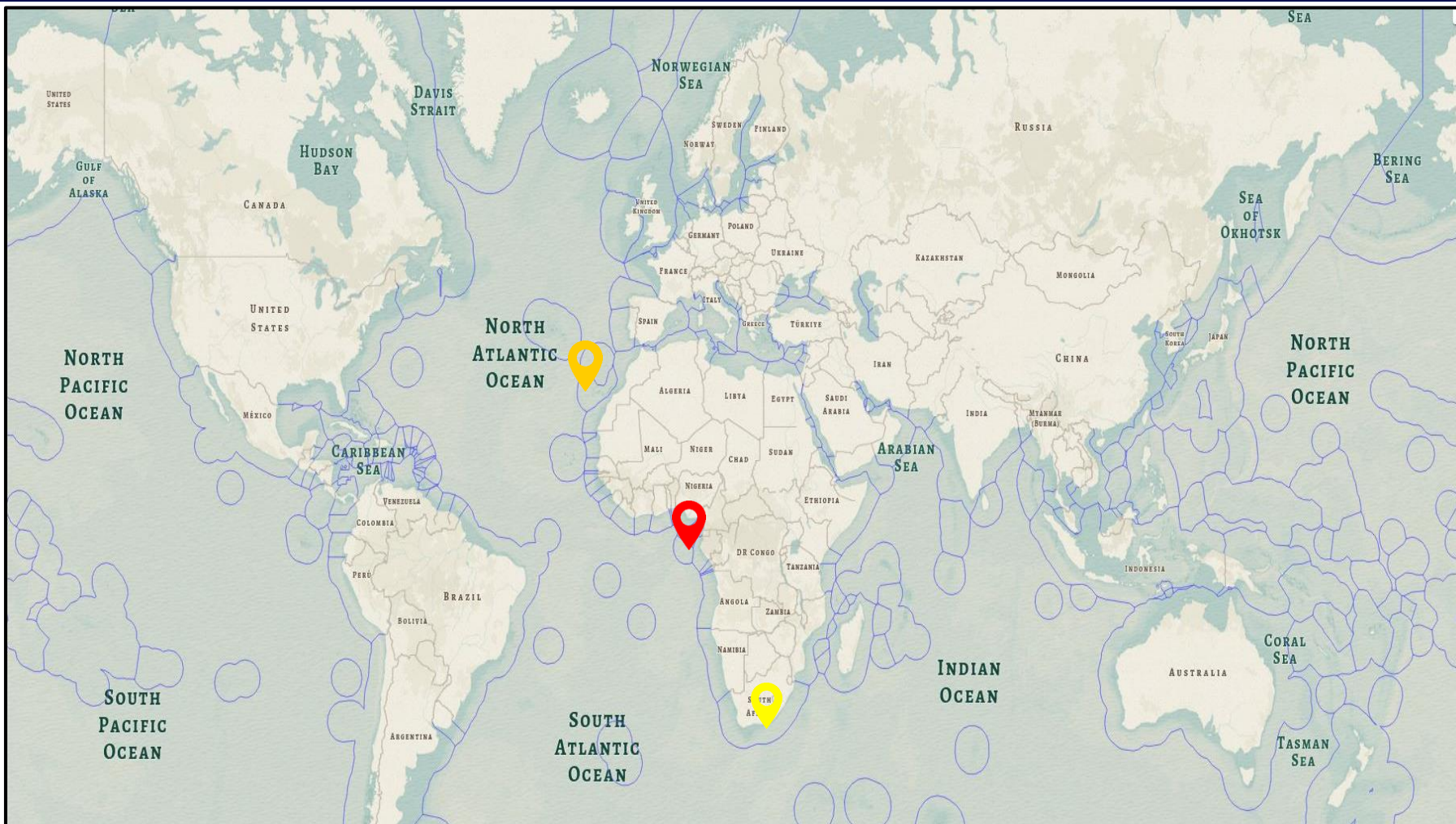


Tropical Cyclone 14S "Duduzai"

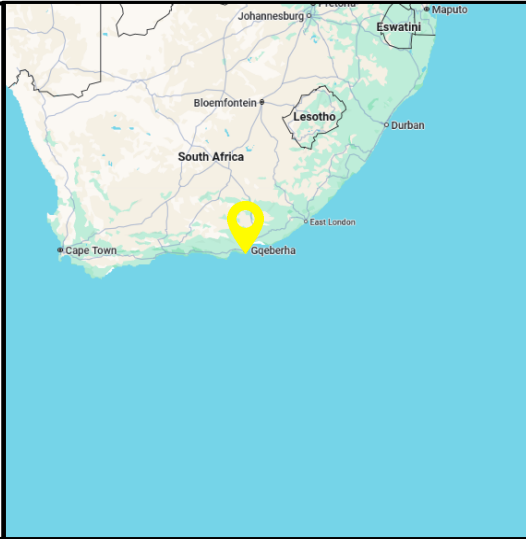

2026.01.12	South Africa	Off the Coast of Gqeberha	Rescue Operations	Name- Silver Dorado Type - fishing vessel	There are no reported injuries among the crew, who have returned safely to land.

Crew members of the Silver Dorado squid fishing vessel successfully escaped a fire that broke out during operations off the coast of Gqeberha. The crew, including skipper Sean Gushwindt, was evacuated thanks to the rapid response from the National Sea Rescue Institute (NSRI) and assistance from nearby vessels.

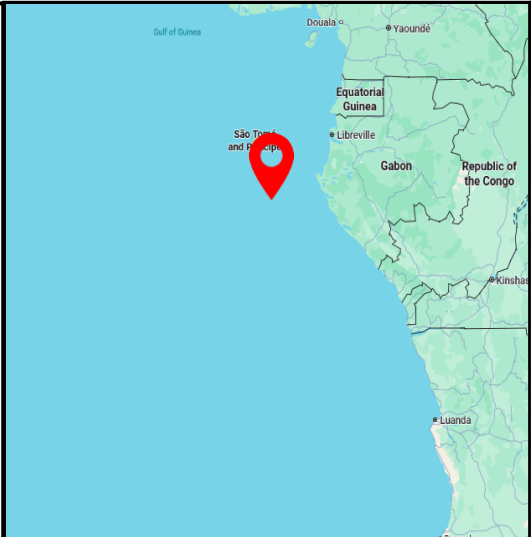

12 Jan/ Pirates Kidnap Chinese Crewmembers From Fishing Vessel/ Gabon.

2026.01.12	Gabon	Off The Coast Of Gabon	Robbery At Sea	Name- IB Fish 7 Type – Fishing Vessel	The abductees comprised five Chinese nationals and four Indonesians, while six crewmembers, including Indonesian, Chinese, and Burkina Faso nationals, remained on board.

On Monday, armed pirates kidnapped nine foreign crewmembers from the Gabonese-flagged fishing vessel IB Fish 7, about seven nautical miles off Ekwata, Gabon, as reported by the Gabonese ministry of defense and maritime security consultancy Vanguard Tech. Around 0200 hours local time, the incident took place while the vessel was fishing.



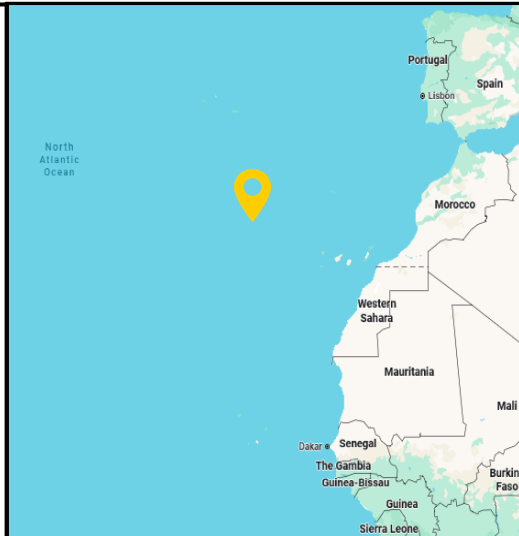

12 Jan/ Spain Makes Largest-Ever Cocaine Bust At Sea After Intercepting Merchant Ship/ Spain

2026.01.12	Spain	Atlantic Ocean	Drugs Hidden In Cargo	Name -United s Flag - Cameroon Type - General Cargo	All 13 crew members were arrested, and a short firearm guarding the drugs was recovered.

Spanish authorities have recorded their largest cocaine seizure at sea, intercepting a Cameroon-flagged merchant ship in the Atlantic Ocean. The vessel, originating from Brazil, was boarded last week, resulting in the confiscation of 9,994 kilograms of cocaine hidden in 294 bales within a cargo of salt.
