

Weather:

OCNL Showers / T>Showers in sections : 55, 60, 65, 70, 75

SCT Showers / T>Showers in sections : 15, 20, 45, 50, 80, 85

ISOL Showers / T>Showers elsewhere.

Winds:

North of Shear line

West of 80E: NE'ly or N'ly / (10-20)kts; gusting up to (20-25) kts in sections 05

East of 80E: N'ly to NW'ly/ (10-15)kts; gusting up to (20-25) kts in sections 10.

In-between Shear line and ITCZ

West of 80E: NW'ly or SW'ly / (10-20)kts; gusting up to 25 kts in section 65

East of 80E: W'ly to NW'ly/ (15-20)kts; gusting up to (25-30) kts in sections 70, 75

South of ITCZ:

West of 70E: W'ly to SW'ly / (10-20)kts.

East of 70E: SE'ly / (10-20)kts; gusting up to (20-25) kts in section 85.

Seas:

Rough in sections : 70

Fairly Rough, rough at times in sections : 65, 75

Moderate, fairly rough at times in sections : 05, 10, 85.

Slight to Moderate elsewhere.

NOTE: Seas can be temporarily very rough during thundershowers.




Tropical Cyclone 14S "Duduzai"







Tropical Storm 01W "Nokaen" & 15S "Ewetse"

19 Jan/ Fire sinks three boats at Umatilla Marina/ United States

2026.01.17	USA	Umatilla Marina	Fire	-	All three burned boats sank despite firefighting efforts. Umatilla Public Works officials used containment booms to prevent the spread of hazardous materials like fuel from the vessels.

Clean up operations are ongoing at Umatilla Marina following a fire that caused three boats to sink. Firefighters responded to a report of a fire at approximately 0627 hrs on 19 Jan discovering two burning boats drifting away from the dock and another still moored. Fortunately damage to nearby vessels was prevented.



2026.01.18	Greece	Gavdos Island	Human Smuggling By Sea	-	The coast guard reported that two men, aged 23 and 19 from South Somalia, were allegedly hired to navigate a vessel from Tobruk in eastern Libya to Gavdos, located off the southern coast of Crete..

A total 79 migrants reached the southern island of Gavdos in a small vessel from northern Africa on Sunday and two of them have been arrested on suspicion of belonging to a migrant smuggling gang, authorities said Monday.



2026.01.18	Russia	Novorossiysk Port	Drone Attack	Name: AURELIA Type: Cargo IMO: 9121895	Damaged containers have been removed from the ship. Surveys are currently being conducted to assess the extent of the damage.

The incident involved a ship around 80-90 nautical miles offshore from Novorossiysk Port Russia. The vessel carrying a crew of 16 was struck yet there were no reported injuries among the crew although some containers sustained damage.
