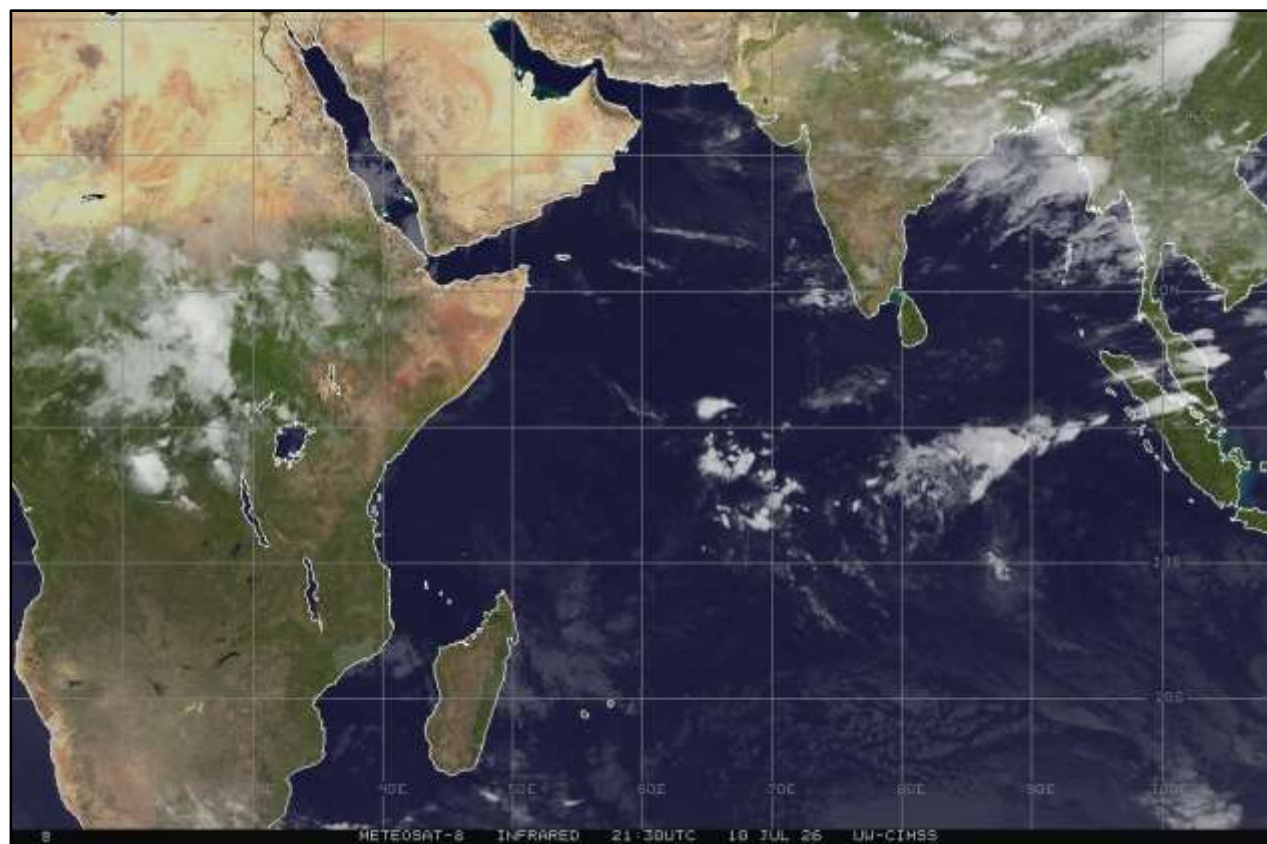

Slight to moderate elsewhere.

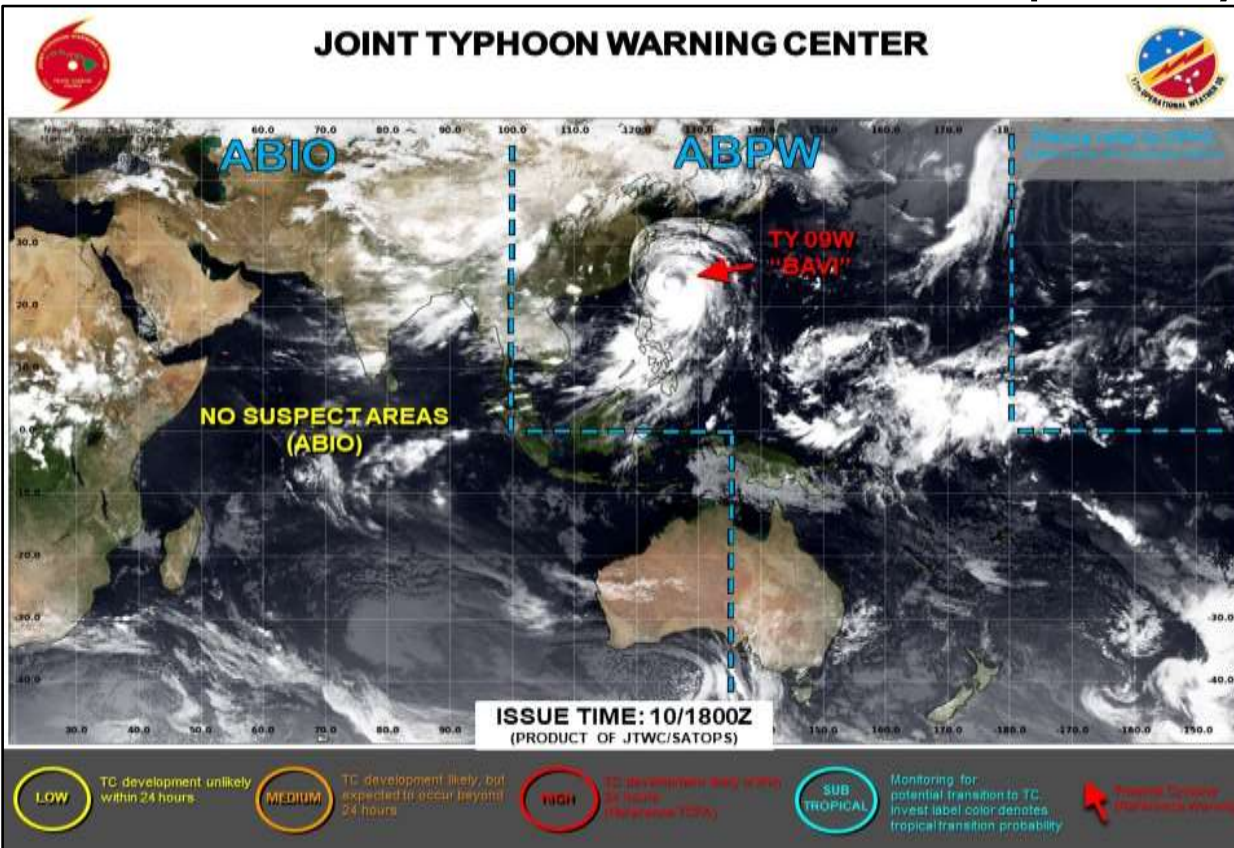

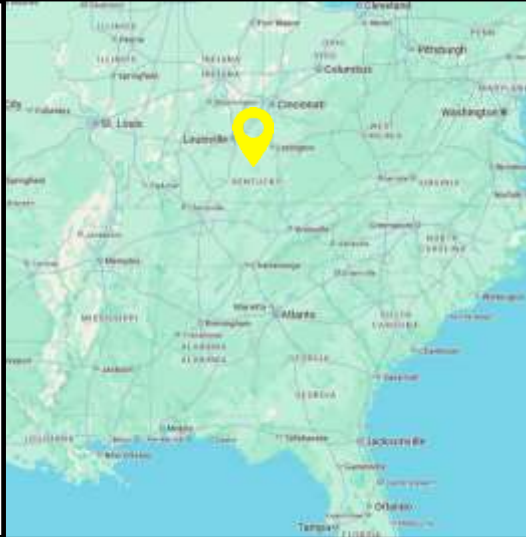

06 Jul/ Rescuers Find Body of Missing Victim of Kentucky Lake Boat Crash/ USA

2026.07.06	USA	Herrington Lake	Search and Rescue (SAR)	-	The body of 25-year-old Nazar Svintizelskiy, a missing victim, was discovered at a depth of 184 feet and has been sent to the coroner's office in Frankfort for an autopsy.

On 06 Jul 26, search teams discovered the body of an adult male missing since a boat accident on Herrington Lake in Mercer County, where a vessel with five individuals struck a pontoon two days earlier. The remaining four occupants were injured, with one survivor in a medically induced coma due to traumatic injuries.

09 Jul/ 2 Confirmed Dead, 50 Rescued After Passenger, Cargo Boat Catches Fire on Lake Victoria/ Tanzania

2026.07.09	Tanzania	Victoria Lake	Fire/Folding/Explosion	Cargo vessel	Two individuals, a 10-year-old boy and a 60-year-old man, have died. The survivors are uninjured but in shock, and they have been taken to health facilities in Bwiro and Lyamwenge for treatment.

At least two individuals have been confirmed dead and 50 rescued after a boat fire on Lake Victoria in northwestern Tanzania. The incident occurred in Ukerewe District while the vessel was en route from Gozba Island to Mwanza. Authorities are still verifying the onboard passenger count, which was initially reported as 52, with two people still unaccounted.

09 Jul/ U.S Strikes Iran's Port of Chabahar After Trump's Announcement To Prepare for More Attacks/ Iran

2026.07.09	Iran	Chabahar Port	Assault violations	-	Fire and explosions were reported at the port, causing panic among civilians and power outages in the city. This incident marks the first attack on the port since the ceasefire began.

The U.S. conducted strikes on Iran's Chabahar port, targeting military facilities and maritime infrastructure. The situation has escalated tensions, with President Trump declaring the peace agreement with Iran "over" and warning of further attacks. The strikes specifically hit piers and a traffic control tower, avoiding civilian and energy facilities.

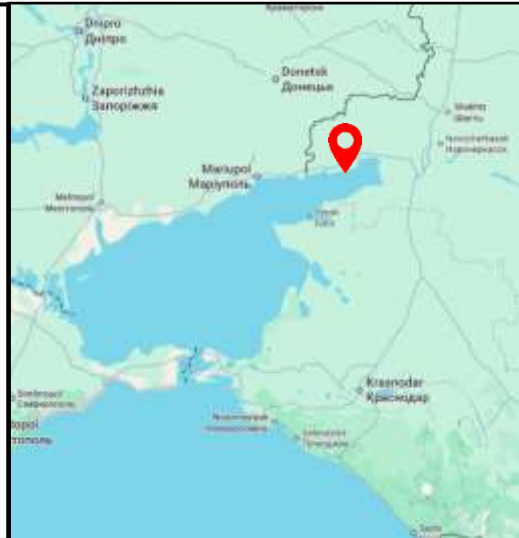

09 Jul/ Refinery and Taganrog Seaport Ablaze After Drone Attacks/ Russia

2026.07.09	Russia	Taganrog sea port	Assault violations	-	In Russia's Rostov region, fires are being extinguished at two fuel depots and at the Taganrog sea port, according to Governor Yury Slyusar. Preliminary information indicates that no injuries have been reported.

Russia's Ilsky oil refinery in the Krasnodar region was set on fire due to a drone attack, coinciding with an evacuation in Taganrog following another strike. Ukraine has increased assaults on Russian energy infrastructure to weaken Moscow's war effort. The Ilsky refinery, which can process approximately 138,000 barrels daily, has faced previous attacks, leading to fuel shortages and rising prices across Russia.

08 Jul/ CMA CGM Notre Dame Takes On First European Bio-LNG in Rotterdam/ Netherlands

2026.07.08	Netherlands	Rotterdam Port	Naval Activities	Name-Cma Cgm Notre Dame Type -Cargo Flag -France	During its initial call at Rotterdam, CMA CGM Notre Dame utilized bio-LNG sourced from European organic waste, according to the Port of Rotterdam. This sustainable fuel lowers greenhouse gas emissions over its lifecycle by at least 67% compared to conventional marine fuels while also significantly decreasing SOx, NOx, and particulate emissions.

The CMA CGM Notre Dame, the world's largest LNG-powered container ship, made its first call at Rotterdam on 8 July, shortly after its naming ceremony in Le Havre on 2 July. This vessel, part of the French-flagged fleet, has a capacity of 24,212 TEU and measures nearly 400 meters in length and 61 meters in beam. It is the first of ten ships in this series, deployed on the French Asia Line 3 (FAL3) service, with planned stops in Hamburg, Antwerp, Tanger Med, Port Klang, and Ningbo.
